TVET Lecturer Capacitation using an Open Learning Modality of Delivery for CPD

The TVET System in Numbers

- 50 Public TVET Colleges
- Close to 270 sites of delivery
- Around 10 000 lecturers
- Approximately 700 000 headcounts annually
- 19 National Certificates (Vocational) [NC(V)]
 on offer in almost 80 subjects across 3 levels
- In the region of 24 NATED programmes on offer in more than 200 subjects

Lecturer CPD needs

- Deepening of content knowledge
- Pedagogical competencies for teaching of practical competencies to students
- Support for development of high quality student assessment tasks
- Use of ICT and multi-media in teaching
- Management of student performance

Why open learning works for CPD!

Lecturers are in full-time employment
Upskilling and reskilling of lecturers an ongoing need
Diversity of needs can be met

"Open learning is an approach which combines the principles of learner-centredness, lifelong learning, flexibility of learning provision, the recognition of credit for prior learning experience, the provision of learner support ..."

Lecturer Support System – LSS

- Online training packages available to lecturers
- Access to teaching tools (lesson plans, videos, assignments, assessment tools).
- Access to DHET documents and teaching resources (Subject and Assessment Guidelines) including workplace related resources.
- Improvement of teaching and professional skills.
- Points allocation towards lecturer CPD
- Resources available 24/7 to lecturers

- Packages for invigilators in the TVET sector
- NC(V) Level 4 Mathematics and Electronic Control and Digital electronic content packages
- Non-dependency on internet, download once and use anywhere, anytime
- Lesson plan templates available and ready for use
- Subject and Learning outcomes focussed
- Time-saving when preparing delivery and administration of lessons


